

# SMALLBORE, 100 Yard Prone

**PLACE:** Centerville Range, Centerville Ut

**Intent:** To have a marksmanship activity that allows folks to use commonly owned, inexpensive to shoot rifles. Using NRA common courses of fire adjusted to the 22 LR. The Match Director retains the right to modify the program, while keeping with the intent. Mini Palma targets, or NRA Smallbore 100 yard targets may be used

**SCHEDULE:** Please show up 30 minutes early to help prep the range and hang targets.. Firing may take place in two or more relays, depending on number of shooters.

**REGISTRATION:** Please notify the Match Director listed above, no later than Wednesday prior to the event to ensure squadding. Firing Points are limited.

**FEES:** Adults, \$15.00, Juniors (Under 21) \$5.00. Centerville small arms association members displaying membership card during registration will have their fees reduced by \$5.00

**RULES:** All shooting will be single shot. This means 1 round is loaded for each shot. (Due to the 22LR rifles that are not easy to shoot Single Load, such as the Ruger 10-22 and clones, AR15 based rimfires, and some tube fed rifles that cannot easily be loaded singly, firing from the magazine will be allowed for those rifles only)  
All firing will be at 100 Yards.

**Targets:** LRS Mini-PALMA targets will be used,. Targets give the same view as the full size targets at the respective distances of 800. 900. and 1000 yards when placed at 100 yards. An alternate target may be used, such as the NRA Smallbore 100 yard target

**PREP TIME:** a 3 minute prep time will be given 2 minutes after the call to bring equipment to the line.

## **COURSE OF FIRE: PALMA**

**Stage 1. Simulators 800 yards. 3 minutes for prep time, 5 Minute Sighter Period (Sighters are not convertible) followed by, 15 Minutes for 15 record shots.**

**Stage 2. Simulates 900 yards. 17 minutes for 2 sighters and 15 record shots,**

**Stage 3. Simulates 1000 yards, 17 minutes for 2 sighters and 15 record shots**

## **COURSE OF FIRE: Midrange**

**Stage 1. Simulators 600 yards. 3 minutes for prep time,**

**5 Minute Sighter Period (Sighters are not convertible) followed by, 20 Minutes for 20 record shots.**

**Stage 2. Simulates 600 yards. 22 minutes for 2 sighters and 20 record shots,**

**Stage 3. Simulates 600 yards, 22 minutes for 2 sighters and 20 record shots**

**SHOOTER CATEGORIES:**

**PALMA CLASS:** Palma Class rifles in .22 caliber LR (Long Rifle) rim-fire. Shooter is required to utilize the prone sling position as described in the NRA Rules for Smallbore competition. Iron sights only. No rifle support (other than sling) is allowed.

**PRONE CLASS:** Prone Class rifles in .22 caliber LR (Long Rifle) rim-fire. Shooter is required to utilize the prone sling position as described in the NRA Rules for Smallbore competition. Scopes only. No rifle support (other than sling) is allowed.

**F-CLASS T/R:** Rifles and Equipment as stated in the NRA F-Class T/R rules, except ammunition must be .22 caliber LR (rim-fire). Rifle may have iron sights or scope installed, a bi-pod may be attached to the rifle for support, and a rear support bag is authorized. Attached bi-pods are the **ONLY** allowed front support in F-Class T/R.

**F-CLASS OPEN:** Rifles and Equipment as stated in the NRA F-Class Open rules, except ammunition must be .22 LR (rim-fire). Rifle may have iron sights or scope installed. Shooters may use any front supporting device not attached to the rifle. A rear support bag is authorized.

**EQUIPMENT:** Spotting scopes, Mats, Shooting Jackets and Gloves are authorized for all categories. Slings allowed in non-supported shooting. Hearing and Eye protection Strongly encouraged.

**AMMUNITION:** Competitors furnish their own ammunition. It must be .22 rim fire. The match requires 45 or 60 shots for record, plus whatever sighter shots are needed. (If shooting on Alternate target, course of fire may be 20 shots fired 3 times, plus sighter shots, please bring 100 rounds of ammunition.
